- allows for personalised learning experiences, tailored to individual students' needs and learning styles
- provides features such as text to speech, voice recognition, and accessibility settings to cater for all students
- is an effective communication tool for teachers, students and parents/caregivers
- students have access to a vast array of educational resources, including ebooks, and education programs and applications
- · fosters collaboration and creativity equipping students with necessary 21st century skills

Our core belief is that the iPad must be used intentionally with carefully selected apps. It is not expected that these devices are used all day, nor will they replace the important need for students to learn to read and write using more traditional forms. Similar to all teaching and learning tools in our school, the iPads will be used to enrich learning experiences.
