Setting up your child's iPad



Follow these steps to set up your child's iPad for use at school (scan the QR Code for more detailed instructions):

<p>Check your child's iPad is capable of running iPadOS 18</p> <p><i>Settings -> General -> About</i></p> <p><i>This ensures that your child's iPad will run the required apps for learning. App lists on website.</i></p>		<input type="checkbox"/>
<p>Name your child's iPad with their class. Eg John M 3B</p> <p><i>Settings -> General -> About -> Name</i></p> <p><i>This ensures your child's iPad can be identified via Air Drop and if lost.</i></p>		<input type="checkbox"/>
<p>Add a passcode</p> <p><i>Settings -> Touch ID & Passcode</i></p> <p><i>This passcode needs to be shared with the classroom teacher so that they can assist your child with any issues that may arise.</i></p>		<input type="checkbox"/>
<p>Set the Narangba State School iLearn wallpaper to the lock screen</p> <p><i>Tap and hold wallpaper image from iLearn website -> Save to Photos. Navigate to the photo app -> select saved photo -> Edit -> Markup Tool (Pen icon) -> Add Text with Student Name and Class -> Done -> Done -> share icon -> Use as wallpaper -> Add -> Set as Wallpaper Pair</i></p> <p><i>This helps with the identification of the device.</i></p>	 	<input type="checkbox"/>
<p>Create a child Apple ID by setting up Family Sharing</p> <p><i>Settings -> Name / Apple ID -> Family Sharing</i></p> <p><i>It is mandatory that the iPad is set up using your child's own Apple ID. This is established through Family Sharing. Please do not establish the iPad with a shared parent Apple ID.</i></p>		<input type="checkbox"/>
<p>Download the Intune Company Portal from the App Store.</p> <p><i>Students will log into this app at school when they are given their log in details from their Classroom Teacher. There will be a staggered start for classes of Year 2 students to bring their iPads into school to be set-up, commencing from Week 3. Please ensure the iPad has the pre-installed Apple apps. ALL SCHOOL APPS WILL BE DOWNLOADED THROUGH COMPANY PORTAL.</i></p>		<input type="checkbox"/>
<p>Allow access to: login.microsoftonline.com AND fed.education.qld.gov.au</p> <p><i>Settings -> Screen Time -> Content and Privacy Restrictions -> App store, media, web & games -> web content - add website</i></p> <p><i>These websites will allow student access to Intune Company Portal.</i></p>		<input type="checkbox"/>

A note about personal / home apps:

- Ensure only age appropriate apps are installed on the device. The minimum age requirement for most social media, games or entertainment content is 13+. These are, but not limited to apps such as Facebook, Messenger, Snapchat, Instagram, Tik Tok, Roblox, Fortnite etc.
- Any apps that are not on the school app list, need be stored in a 'Home Folder'. These apps are not to be used at school.
- We recommend setting up 'Screen Time' for iPad use at home. You can set up Downtime, App Limits and Content & Privacy in Screen Time settings with the limitations that you want for your child.

Disable – <i>iCloud Storage and Photos</i>
Enable - <i>Speak Selection</i>
Turn off - <i>Background refresh</i>
Enable - <i>Predictive Text</i>
Enable – <i>Dictation</i>
